RESOLUTION 17-19

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE HYRUM CITY BUILDING PERMIT INSPECTION AND CONNECTION FEE SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, on January 6, 1994, the Hyrum City Council passed and posted an ordinance adopting the "Hyrum City Municipal Code", a recodification of municipal ordinances encompassing the "Revised Ordinances of Hyrum City" and ordinances adopted through July 15, 1993; and

WHEREAS, Title 16 of the Hyrum City Municipal Code is known as the Subdivision Ordinance of Hyrum City and sets forth regulations governing the development of subdivisions within the municipal limits, including authorization to establish fee schedules by resolution; and

WHEREAS, there is no fee set for storm water inspections and Hyrum City's Ordinance along with State and Federal mandates require subdivisions to have a storm water management plan and for each building lot to be inspected on a monthly basis for enforcement of storm water requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City has hired J.U.B. Engineering to conduct and manage storm water inspections for all building lots that are required to have a permit and the City is going to require the person/business obtaining the building permit to pay a storm water inspection fee of \$150 per building permit; and

WHEREAS, the City requires a developer to install a culinary water and/or pressurized irrigation connections to each building lot in a subdivision but didn't require a developer/property owner on a regular City Block to install a culinary water and/or pressurized irrigation connections but instead the City would charge a fee and would install the connection including road boring if necessary; and

WHEREAS, City Staff, in order to maintain continuity throughout the City, is recommending requiring all developers/property owners including those on City blocks to install culinary water and/or pressurized irrigation connections including road boring if necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, upon the recommendation of the City Administrator, has determined there is a need to amend connection policies and fees as authorized under Section 16.20.040 of Title 16 of the Hyrum City Municipal Code.
