

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
CITY OF HYRUM, UTAH**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council (the "*Council*") of Hyrum City, Utah (the "*City*") adopted a resolution (the "*Resolution*") on August 19, 2010, providing for the issuance and sale of up to \$2,000,000 of water revenue bonds (the "*Bonds*") of the City, and calling a public hearing to receive input from the public with respect to the issuance of the Bonds and the potential economic impact that the improvements, facilities, or properties to be financed in whole or in part by the Bonds will have on the private sector, pursuant to Section 11-14-318, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended.

The City intends to issue the Bonds for the purpose of financing the costs of acquisition and construction of a water tank and related improvements (the "*Project*"), satisfying any debt service reserve requirement and paying costs and expenses incident thereto.

The City intends to issue the Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

The City will not pledge any taxes of the City for the payment of the Bonds. Instead, the City will pledge, pursuant to that certain Master Resolution Providing for the Issuance of Water Revenue Bonds of the City (the "*Master Resolution*") and one or more Supplemental Resolutions authorizing the issuance and sale of the Bonds (collectively, the "*Supplemental Resolution*") the revenues attributable to the City's water system, for the payment of the Bonds.

The Council will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on October 7, 2010. The public hearing will be held at the regular meeting place of the Council, located at 83 West Main Street, Hyrum, Utah. All members of the public are invited to attend and participate in the public hearing. Prior to the public hearing, written comments may be submitted to the City, to the attention of the City Recorder, at 83 West Main Street, Hyrum, Utah 84319.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive input from the public with respect to the issuance of the Bonds for the purpose of financing or refinancing all or part of the cost of the Project and the potential economic impact that the Project will have on the private sector.
