Mayors Message – We are fortunate to live in a community that values recreation. The Uniform National Land Standard suggests 10 acres of recreational property per 1,000 people. Hyrum is well past that standard, with 29 acres per 1,000 people and a total of more than 173 acres of recreational property available to the public.

Hyrum has 13 parks with amenities like playgrounds, a soccer complex, rodeo grounds, lighted baseball and softball diamonds and tennis courts. The city also owns and maintains parcels of land up Blacksmith Fork Canyon, where you'll find a day-use lodge and primitive camping. There are plenty of

nearby trails for hiking and biking.

City Council Meeting Summary – The City Council gave approval to the county to put the formation of a Cache Water District on the November ballot.

Renewal of the contract Hyrum City has with the Cache County Sheriff's Department was approved. There are no increases in costs.

The Cache County Trail Coordinator discussed future projects. One of them is a trail going up Blacksmith Fork Canyon.

Kelly Calderwood was approved for a home occupation business license for a preschool at 236 South 1100 East.

Jeff Covert's site plan was approved for an auto repair shop at 40 West 300 North.

The council approved amendments to the final plat for phases 1 & 3 of the Blacksmith Fork Villas Retirement Community located at 650 East Main. They changed six single family lots to two triplexes. Preliminary plat approval for Rolling Hills phase three was given, which consists of 10 single family building lots.

A wastewater self-assessment report for 2015 was approved.

Preliminary Plat approval was given for Hidden Valley Subdivision, located at 30 North 650 West, consisting of 43 single family building lots.

The council accepted the petition for annexation for Kilgore Companies for construction of Johnson's ready mix batch plant. This means that the council has agreed to consider the annexation agreement being worked out.

The council approved resolutions an agreement to renew the city's contract with Intermountain Power Agency and an agreement to sale excess power to them.

New Senior Center Board Members were approved: Ada Beth Winder, Gwen Christiansen, and Curt Ellison. We express thanks to those going off the board for their service: Pat Brimhall, Linda Christiansen, and Claude Long.


