NEW Winter Parking Restrictions - Winter parking restrictions begin November 1st. Parking is not allowed on city streets or within ten feet of roadway pavement in any municipal right-of-way, unless such vehicle is in a driveway approach or otherwise parked behind the curb where curb exists for a period longer than fifteen minutes when loading or unloading or delivering property between the hours of **11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.** This law allows for snow removal and is in effect until April 1st, even when there is no snow.

Green Waste – The curbside green waste collection continues until November 18th. The green waste bins provided at East Park will be removed on November 18th for the winter. Please do not dispose of any waste once bins are removed.

Museum News - Did you know that 125 years ago, Utah made history by electing Martha Hughes Cannon to be the first female State Senator in the nation? As a frontier doctor, suffragist, and senator, Martha was such a trailblazer that her statue has been chosen to represent Utah in the US Capitol in Washington DC! The museum is thrilled to be part of the celebration by hosting the traveling exhibit "Legacy of Leadership". Join us on November 12th from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for the exhibit's grand opening at our Second Saturday event. The exhibit, which honors Martha and Utah women's rich legacy of leadership will only be at the museum through Thursday, December 15th, so don't miss it.

We will explore the Martha Hughes Cannon exhibit and complete an art activity to learn more about Martha at the museum's "Sound the Cannon" Back in Time children's activity November 15th - 17th from 1:00 -1:30 p.m. each day. All children are welcome to attend from preschool-aged to older kids who are homeschooled, and sign-up is encouraged.

Everyone is invited to the Elite Hall on Friday, November 4th for the season's first FREE Family Movie Night! We will be showing DC League of Super Pets on the big screen.
