Mayors Message – Local participating municipalities have joined together and formed the Cache Waste Consortium. A request for proposals to haul garbage was issued and proposals were accepted until the end of August. There were four companies that submitted bids. Presentations were presented to the consortium the beginning of December. In January, it was agreed to begin negotiations with one of the haulers. Once negotiations are finished and a contract is signed, we will be able to give you more

details on who the hauler is and when we will begin the change in services.

NEW Winter Parking Restrictions - Parking is not allowed on city streets or within ten feet of roadway pavement in any municipal right-of-way, unless such vehicle is in a driveway approach or otherwise parked behind the curb where curb exists for a period longer than fifteen minutes when loading or unloading or delivering property between the hours of **12:00 midnight to 8:00 a.m. and when a snowstorm is predicted no parking after 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.** This law allows for snow removal and is in effect until April 1st, even when there is no snow.

Indoor Walking - The Elite Hall is open for free public walking every Monday—Friday from 7:00—10:00 a.m. All are welcome, but please supervise children and don't bring any food or drinks other than water.

Spring Clean-Up - Dumpsters will be available for your use at East Park (700 East Main) April 26th – May 4th 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. Remember please **DO NOT** discard these items in the dumpsters: tires, automotive batteries, motor oil, antifreeze, chemicals, ashes, fireworks, and paint. Metal recycling bins will be available for any metal (aluminum, steel, etc.). Please remember that refrigerators will be accepted only if Freon is drained.

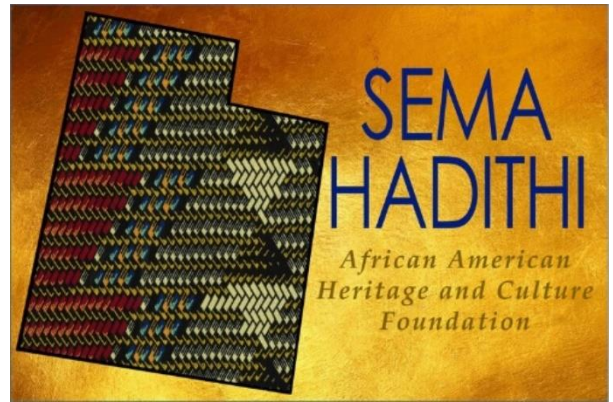

Museum News - Did you know that “Sema Hadithi” means “to tell the story” in Swahili? Accordingly, the Sema Hadithi African American Heritage and Culture Foundation is Utah's premiere black history organization, which is dedicated solely to the research, discovery, preservation, and telling the story of Utah's black history, which starts prior to European settlement and continues to present day. They accomplish this work through teams that focus on a specific aspect of black life in Utah. The teams collect information that is already available, such as archival, historical, and governmental records, plus seek out undiscovered resources, then create a well-developed narrative to share with the community through lectures, panel discussions, publications, and exhibits. Currently, their “Utah's Black Veterans” exhibit is open at the Hyrum Museum through March, which we will explore during our Back in Time Children's Activity “Off We Go!” on March 28th — 30th from 1:00—1:30 p.m. each day. We will specifically learn more about a couple of Utah's black female veterans who served in the Air Force. All children are welcome to attend.

Sema Hadithi also builds connections to cultural organizations, nurtures relationships with government agencies, and provides the vision that moves the effort forward including their regional “Scan-n-Go” events, which capture both historic and contemporary stories of Black Utahns. The museum is honored to host a Sema Hadithi “Scan-n-Go” event for our SUPER SATURDAY on March 25th from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Vivid Pix donated a computer and a scanner to Sema Hadithi to collect individual



personal histories of Black Utahns to more fully capture the stories of Black Americans in Utah. All Utahns of African descent are invited to the museum to share their stories, along with any photographs and/or documents they would like to bring.

Don't miss our final FREE Family Movie of the season! Join us on Friday, March 3rd to watch Puss in Boots: The Last Wish on the big screen at the Elite Hall. Doors open at 6:30 p.m. and the movie will begin at 7:00 p.m. Wear your comfy clothes, bring your pillows, blankets, bean bags, camp chairs, etc. and your own dinner and/or treats. This is a free public event.

The museum is honored to partner with the Utah Cold War Veterans Foundation to recognize all local veterans of the Cold War. Anyone who served at any time between September 2, 1945 and December 26, 1991 is eligible. Please contact Jami at museum@hyrumcity.com (or come into the museum) to be added to the list.
