Spring Clean-Up - Dumpsters will be available for your use at East Park (700 East Main) April 26th – May 4th 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. Remember please **DO NOT** discard these items in the dumpsters: tires, automotive batteries, motor oil, antifreeze, chemicals, ashes, fireworks, and paint. Metal recycling bins will be available for any metal (aluminum, steel, etc.). Please remember that refrigerators will be accepted only if Freon is drained.

IMPORTANT Sewer Department NOTICE - Hyrum City is asking everyone to be considerate of what is flushed down the toilet. Keep it simple, and stick to the three P's, Pee, Poop and Paper (toilet paper), that's it.

Recently, the main sewer line was clogged with solids that do not belong in the system. Unfortunately, this caused sewer to back up in a few people's homes. Most of the larger solids that clogged the line were flushable wipes and feminine hygiene products, namely tampons. These items do not belong in the sewer system. Despite flushable wipes misleading name, they should not be flushed and have been the cause of many systems backups throughout the country.



So please, be aware of what goes down your drain. It cannot only plug off your lateral but can also cause a sewer backup in your neighbor's line downstream. Neither of which is covered by the City's insurance. We encourage each homeowner to work with your homeowner's insurance agent to make sure you have the coverage you need and want for sewer backups and floods.

Hyrum City regularly cleans out the sewer lines to industry standards at the expense of over \$50,000 a year. If cleanings must be increased, it will come at a cost to the taxpayers. Please educate the members of your household and let's prevent these types of issues.
